

## BCS EAP PROTOCOL

Emergency Action Plan is designed to help those who are involved with athletics to know what to do when an emergency occurs. This is an extension of the EAP in the safety and procedure book. This may be altered at any time if needed.

When athletic trainer (ATC) is present:

### **Athlete injured possible emergency and is conscious**

- ATC in control
  - Decide if EMS needs to be called. ATC will signal with arms in the air making an “X”
- Head Coach
  - Assist ATC
- Assistant Coach
  - Watch for the sign for the need of an ambulance
  - Call “911” and direct the ambulance
  - Recruit two people to assist in directing the ambulance
- Parent/Scorekeeper
  - Assist with team
  - Help with the crowd
- Athletic Director (AD)
  - Crowd control
  - Contact parent
  - Assist as needed in other areas

### **Athlete injured non-responsive/LOC**

- ATC in control
  - Signals for EMS with arms in an “X” position
- Head Coach
  - AED
  - Assist with CPR if needed
- Assistant Coach
  - Call “911” and direct the ambulance
  - Recruit two people to assist in directing the ambulance
- Parent/Scorekeeper
  - Assist with team
  - Help with crowd
- Athletic Director (AD)
  - Crowd control
  - Contact parent
  - Assist as needed in other areas

When athletic trainer is **not** present:

**Athlete injured possible emergency and is conscious**

- Head Coach in control
  - Decide if EMS needs to be called. Head Coach will signal with arms in the air making an “X”
- Assistance Coach
  - Assist Head Coach
- Athletic Director (AD)
  - Watch for the sign for the need of an ambulance
  - Call “911” and direct the ambulance
  - Recruit two people to assist in directing the ambulance
- Parent/Scorekeeper
  - Assist with team
  - Help with the crowd
  - Contact parent

**Athlete injured non-responsive/LOC**

- Head Coach in control
  - Signals for EMS with arms in an “X” position
- Assistant Coach
  - AED
  - Assist with CPR if needed
- Athletic Director
  - Call “911” and direct the ambulance
  - Recruit two people to assist in directing the ambulance
